PUBLIC MEASURE “A”

“Shall the following public measure be adopted?”

SUMMARY: Shall the Scott County Public Safety Authority issue \$29,700,000 in revenue bonds to renovate and expand existing jail facilities?”

“Shall the Scott County Public Safety Authority, a building authority incorporated by Scott County, Iowa and the City of Davenport, Iowa pursuant to Section 346.27 of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of acquiring, demolishing, improving, enlarging, equipping, furnishing, repairing, maintaining and operating one or more public buildings for the joint use of the County, the City or any school district which is part of the County, issue its revenue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$29,700,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, furnishing, equipping, renovating, and expanding existing jail facilities for the joint use of the County and the City?”

PUBLIC MEASURE “B” - CITY OF LECLAIRE ONLY

“Shall the following public measure be adopted?”

SUMMARY: To authorize a change in **USE** of the one percent(1%) local sales and services tax in the City of LeClaire, Scott County, Iowa, effective with any and all revenues received after July 1, 2005.

The **USE** of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of LeClaire, Scott County, Iowa, shall be changed effective with any and all revenues received after July 1, 2005.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:
