**RE: Flood Debris Clean Up-Unincorporated Scott County**

Scott County Secondary Roads and Scott County Conservation, in partnership with the Waste Commission of Scott County, will be assisting residents of unincorporated Scott County impacted by the recent Mississippi River and Wapsipinicon River flooding with flood debris collection. Collection will begin on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 and proceed through the county as outlined below.

**Debris Collection:** The following items will be collected:

- Construction debris (building materials, drywall, lumber, carpet, furniture, plumbing)
- Bulky waste (flood impacted furniture, doors, carpet, padding)
- Large appliances (Refrigerators, washers, dryers, water heaters)

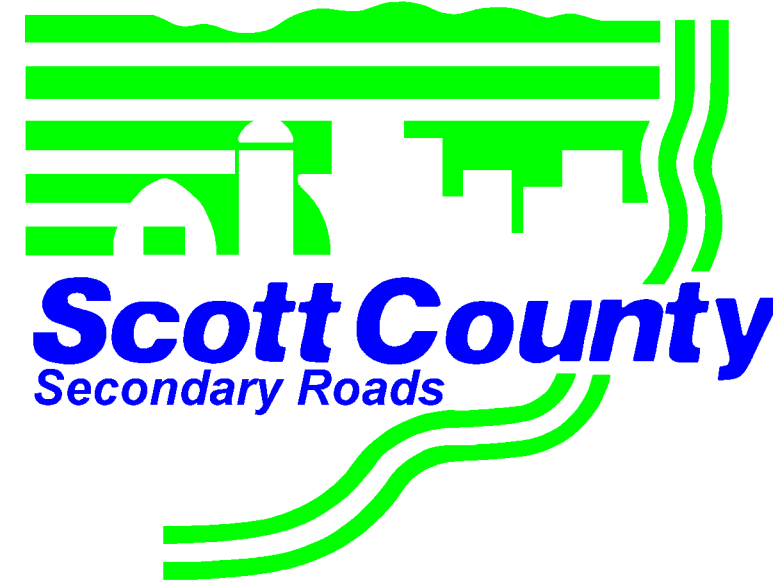
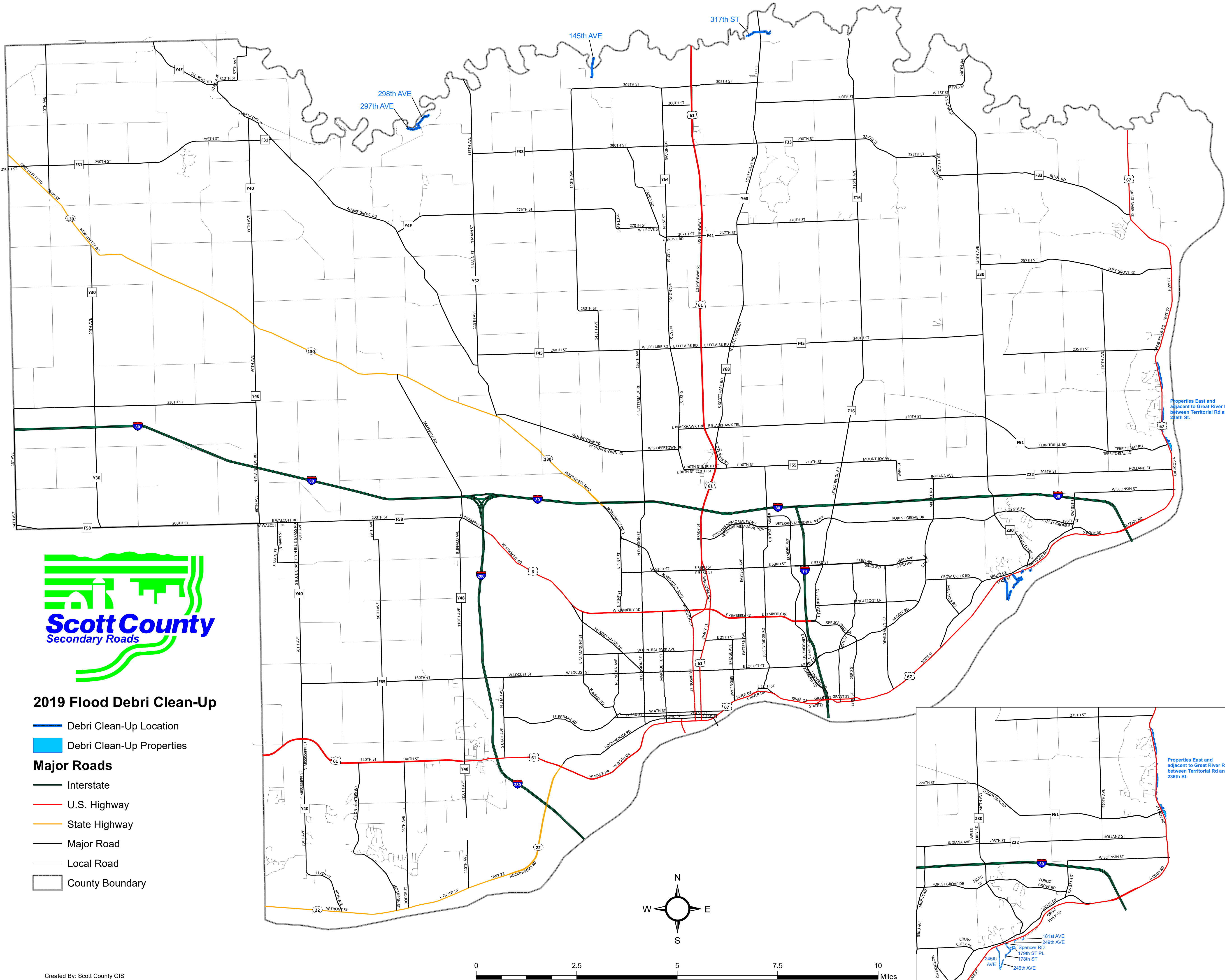
\* *The following will NOT be picked up: household garbage (bagged garbage, discarded food, packaging), hazardous materials (oil, pesticides, paint, cleaners, compressed gases, propane tanks), and electronics (TVs, stereos, computers, tablets, printers); find out how to dispose of these items:*

**Order of Clean Up Locations**

- 297<sup>th</sup> and 298<sup>th</sup> Streets North of River Camp Road
- 145<sup>th</sup> Avenue North of 144<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- 317<sup>th</sup> Street East and West of Scott Park Road
- Properties East and adjacent to Great River Road between Territorial Rd and 235<sup>th</sup> Street
- 249<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 181<sup>st</sup> Street East
- 181<sup>st</sup> Street South of Great River Road
- Spencer Road South of Hwy 67 including 179<sup>th</sup> Street Place, 179<sup>th</sup> Street and 178<sup>th</sup> Street
- 245<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 246<sup>th</sup> Avenue South of Great River Road

Residents are asked to have flood debris to the road by Monday, May 20, 2019 in order to assist with collection scheduling. Secondary Roads and Conservation will not be returning to areas for additional pick up after the scheduled pick up is complete. 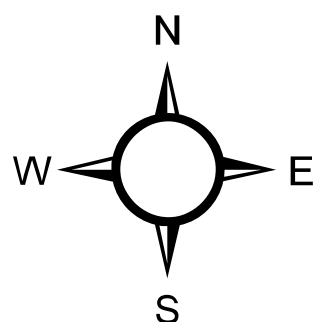


**2019 Flood Debris Clean-Up**
